ADDITIONAL WORKPLACE POSTERS

- ☐ MN SERVICE ANIMALS POSTER – Post in a retail store, hotel, or other place of public accommodation to let patrons know that service animals are welcome but misrepresenting a pet as a service animal is a crime. (#23704)
- ☐ MN NO SMOKING POSTER – Employers and operators of places of employment and public places must make efforts to deter smoking, including by posting appropriate signage. (#23701)
- ☐ MINNEAPOLIS EMPLOYEE RIGHTS (#23702) or ST. PAUL EARNED SICK AND SAFE TIME (#23703) – City posters, required if employees work 80+ hours annually within the city.
